Author and Title	Give the title and author of the novel.	5	
Setting	Give the location and time period of the novel. Explain how these elements work together to affect the story.	10	
Character Sketch	Complete for a prominent character in the novel. Each section of the organizer is worth 2 points. An incomplete sketch is at least a 5 point deduction.	10	
Conflict	Explain the conflict and give supporting evidence from the novel. Options: protagonist vs. antagonist, protagonist vs. self, protagonist vs. nature, protagonist vs. society	10	
Plot	Sequentially describe 4-7 important events of the story, explaining how they are related.	10	
Conflict Resolution	Explain how the events in the plot lead up to the conflict being resolved.	10	
Theme	What message is the author trying to send the reader? What makes you think this is what the author is saying? Give support from the text.	10	
Author's Craft	Choose one writing technique the writer uses that you feel made the novel more interesting. Give 2-3 examples of use of this technique in the novel.	10	
Visual Aid	Create a visual that will aid your presentation. The aid should help the audience better understand an important aspect of the novel.	10	
Genre	If the report is accurate and descriptive, audience members should be able to correctly give the genre you believe this book belongs to.	10	
Recommendation	Who would you recommend to read this book? Why? What made you like or dislike the book?	5
